Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honour. Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints; extend hospitality to strangers. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly; do not claim to be wiser than you are. Do not repay anyone evil for evil, but take thought for what is noble in the sight of all. If it is possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave room for the wrath of God; for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.' 

Your Eminence/Excellency,

In July, Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, President of our Conference, and I announced the designation of Sunday, November 26, as A Day of Prayer for Persecuted Christians that initiates "Solidarity in Suffering," a Week of Awareness and Education. The Solemnity of Christ the King is a fitting time to reflect on religious freedom and persecution.

USCCB is collaborating with the Knights of Columbus, Catholic Relief Services, CNEWA and Aid to the Church in Need on this project. In addition, Catholic schools and parish religious education programs will also have access to educational materials produced in conjunction with "In RESPONSE to PERSECUTION: Findings of the Under Caesar's Sword Project on Global Christian Communities," produced by Notre Dame's Center for Ethics and Culture, the Religious Freedom Institute, and Aid to the Church in Need.
