



عبرانيين 1:1-12. Birth of the Lord أحد ألميلاد — 12-13

Long ago God spoke to our ancestors in many and various ways by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, through whom he also created the worlds. He is the reflection of God's glory and the exact imprint of God's very being, and he sustains all things by his powerful word. When he had made purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs. For to which of the angels did God ever say, 'You are my Son; today I have begotten you'? Or again, 'I will be his Father, and he will be my Son'? And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, 'Let all God's angels worship him.' Of the angels he says, 'He makes his angels winds, and his servants flames of fire.' But of the Son he says, 'Your throne, O God, is for ever and ever, and the righteous scepter is the scepter of your kingdom. You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness beyond your companions.' And, 'In the beginning, Lord, you founded the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands; they will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like clothing; like a cloak you will roll them up, and like clothing they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will never end.'

DRYNESS IN PRAYER: GRIEF

Praying during a season of loss can be hard. When I think of my own seasons of loss or of listening to others' prayer during their seasons of grief, I can think of multiple descriptions of prayer that sounded something like:

- → I cannot even sit down to pray, because my mind races everywhere when I try to pray.
- ♦ Being still is hard, because so much hits me at once that I don't know where to start.
- → I am not even sure if God is there or hearing me in my pain.
- → Prayer feels dry and empty.
- → I cannot be still or even sit still.

As with most things, it's always easier for me to reflect back on these seasons and remember what worked than to figure it out when I am in the middle of living a season of loss and trying to continue to grow in my prayer life. Here are three things that I try to remember myself and also offer to others who are in this season.

- **1. Pray as you can, not as you can't:** ... How I used to be able to pray might not work right now. ... While the stillness of prayer did not work for me, physically moving and talking to God or just being in nature and walking did.
- **2. Try puttering prayer:** Puttering prayer is a prayer method shared with me by a friend and colleague. She gave herself permission to "putter," and when she felt called, she would turn her attention to God in the moment and then carry on with her day. I find this way of praying very helpful when grief has a hold of me and I cannot sit down to a long prayer period.

3. Talk to God openly and honestly, even if in short spurts.

Our tendency sometimes is to stop prayer all together when it no longer feels the same or our prayer life changes. This can spin us into desolation when we stop praying all together. When facing a loss, I find it is helpful simply to talk to God often in heartfelt, honest conversation. Upon hearing a friend died, I held on to this type of prayer for weeks after her death. I would go about my day and remember her and then talk to God briefly about what was on my mind. Maybe it was a prayer of thanksgiving for a memory or the gift of her friendship. Other times, I might feel angry she was gone. Sometimes, I would simply weep and talk to God about how much I missed her. All our conversations were short but honest.

Eventually, the rawness of a new loss subsides a bit, and as it does, we can return to a season of prayer in which we can sit still longer, and we can face the silence again. Until that time comes, though, we can continue on in our prayer lives as gently as possible, trusting that God will welcome us back every time we come.

Luke 2,1-20.

In those days a decree went out from Emperor Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration and was taken while Quirinius was governor of Syria. All went to their own towns to be registered. Joseph also went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to the city of David called Bethlehem, because he was descended from the house and family of David. He went to be registered with Mary, to whom he was engaged and who was expecting a child. While they were there, the time came for her to deliver her child. And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in bands of cloth, and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn. In that region there were shepherds living in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. Then an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid; for see I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be a sign for you: you will find a child wrapped in bands of cloth and lying in a manger.' And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host, praising God and saying, 'Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors!' When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, 'Let us go now to Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has made known to us.' So they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the child lying in the manger. When they saw this, they made known what had been told them about this child; and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds told them. But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart. The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them.

فى تِلْكَ الأَيَّام، صَدَرَ أَمْرٌ مِنْ أَغُوسُطُسَ قَيْصَرَ بِإِحْصَاءِ كُلِّ الْمَعْمُورَةُ جَرَى هذا الاحْصَاءُ الأُوَّل، عِنْدَمَا كانَ كِيرِينيُوسُ والِيًا على سُورِيًّا. وكانَ الجَمِيعُ يَذَهَبُون، كُلُّ و احِدِ إِلَى مَدِبنَتِهِ، لِبَكْتَتِبُوا فِيهَا و وَصَعِدَ بُوسُفُ أَبِضًا مِنَ الجَلِبِل، مِنْ مَدبِنَةِ النَّاصِرِ ة، إلى البِّهُو دِيَّة، إلى مَدبِنَةِ دَاوُدَ الَّتِي ثُدْعَى بَيْتَ لَحْم، لأنَّهُ كَانَ مِن بَيْتِ دَاوُدَ و عَشِيرَ تِهِ، لِيَكْتَتِبَ مَعَ مَرْ يُمَ خِطِّيبَتِهِ، وهِيَ حَامِل وفِيمًا كَانَا هُنَاك، تَمَّتْ أَبَّامُهَا لِتَلِد، فو لَدَتِ ٱبنَهَا ٱلبِكْرِ ، و قَمَّطْتُهُ، و أَضْجَعَتْهُ في مِدْوَد، لأنَّهُ لَمْ يَكُنْ لَهُمَا مَوْضِعٌ في قَاعَةِ الضُّيُوف. وكَانَ فِي تِلْكَ النَّاحِيَةِ رُعَاةٌ يُقِيمُونَ فِي الْحُقُولِ، ويَسْهَرُونَ في هَجَعَاتِ اللَّيْلِ على قُطْعَانِهِم. فإذًا بِمَلاكِ الرَّبِّ قَدْ وقَّفَ بِهُم، و مَجْدُ الرَّبِّ أَشْر َقَ حَو لَهُم، فَخَافُوا خَو قَا عَظِيمًا. فقالَ لَهُمُ المَلاك: »لا تَخَافُوا! فَهَا أَنَا أَبشِّرُكُمْ بِفَرَحٍ عَظِيمٍ يَكُونُ لِلشَّرُكُمْ بِفَرَحٍ عَظِيمٍ يَكُونُ لِلشَّعْبِ كُلِّهِ، لأَنَّهُ وُلِدَ لَكُمُ ٱليَوْمَ مُخَلِّس، هُوَ ٱلْمَسِيحُ الرَّبّ، في مَدِينَةِ دَاوُد. وهذهِ عَلامَةٌ لَكُم: تَجِدُونَ طِفْلاً مُقَمَّطًا، مُضْجَعًا في مِدْوَد! وٱنْضَمَّ فَجْأَةً إلى المَلاكِ جُمْهُورٌ مِنَ الجُنْدِ السَّمَاوِيِّ بُسِبِّحُونَ ٱللهُ ويَقُولُونَ: أَلمَجْدُ للهِ في العُلي، وعَلَى الأرْضُ السَّلام، والرَّجَاءُ الصَّالِحُ لِبَني البَسَر ولمَّا المُصرَفَ المُلائِكةُ عَنْهُم إلى السَّمَاء، قالَ الرَّعَاةُ بَعْضُهُم لِبَعْضَ: »هيَّا بِنَا، إلى بَلْيُتَ لَحْم، لِنَرَى هذا ٱلأَمْرَ الَّذي حَدَث، وقد أعْلَمَنا بهِ الرَّبّ وجَاؤُوا مُسْرِعِين، فوَجَدُو[ّ]ا مَرْيمَ ويُوسُف، والطُّفْلَ مُضنجَعًا في المِدْوَد. ولمَّا رَأُوهُ أَخْبَرُوا بِالْكَلَامِ الَّذِي قِيلَ لَهُم في شَأَن أَهْذَا الصَّبِيِّ. وجَمِّيعُ الَّذِينَ سَمَعُوا، تَعَجَّبُوا مِمَّا قَالَهُ لَهُمُ الرُّعَاةِ أَمَّا مَرَّيَمُ فَكَانَتْ تَحْفَظُ هذهِ الْأُمُورَ كُلُّهَا، وتتَّأُمُّلُهَا في قلبها. ثُمَّ عَادُ الرُّعَاةُ وهُمْ يُمَجِّدُونَ اللهُ ويُسَبِّحُونَهُ على كُلِّ ما سَمِعُوا ورأوا، حَسَبَما قِيْلَ لَهُم

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
