




Religious Education - 2018-2019



Tithing is a word that simply means one-tenth.The tithe looks back to the ancient practice of offering to God a small portion of the harvest or the sacrifice of a young animal to express gratitude on the part of those who enjoy the fruits of the harvest and animal life around them.

Strictly interpreted, the precept of tithing would mean pledging one-tenth of one's income to the support of the Church. Few Catholics do this today, nor are any obliged to meet the 10 percent standard.

It is encouraging to see that young Catholics these days are notably generous in their commitment to community service. As they grow older, their Church just might resurrect and reconstruct the tithe — 10 percent — and break it down to 5 percent of income and five hours a week of community service. This adds up to an apples-and-oranges total of 10.

If, as the old saying reminds us, "It is in giving that we receive," a revival of the tithe would produce a nice return on

that investment to all who give with the certain knowledge that the Lord will never be outdone in generosity.
