COMMUNICATION

GOING LIVE: LITURGIES AND DEVOTIONS

Dear St. Anthony Parishioners,

We are writing to provide Parish updates considering the latest safety measures implemented by MA Governor Charlie Baker across the state and the most recent directive received from our Shepherd, The Most Reverend Bishop Gregory J. Mansour. We want to ensure that we do not play a role in allowing this pandemic (Coronavirus) to spread further. Effective immediately:

All Ministries, Parish Events, Social Gatherings, Meetings (including Bible Studies) are cancelled.

The Clergy will continue to offer daily Divine Liturgy (as attendance is generally under 25 people)

Weekend Liturgies will be offered via <u>live-stream</u> —Parish Facebook at 4:00pm (English-Saturday), 8:15am (Arabic), 9:30am (English) and 11:30am (English/Arabic) via our Parish Facebook Page.

The church will be opened but attendance is limited to 25 people. The families requesting the Liturgy intentions are given priority.

For those watching live-stream, **Spiritual Communion** is recommended. <u>Please see below for the</u> prayer to be recited in place of receiving physical communion.

Please note that **our Bishop has granted dispensation** to all the Faithful, relieving them of attending to their Sunday Liturgy Obligation during this time (dispensation means that not attending Sunday Liturgy will not be considered a sin).

- On **Wednesdays**, at **6:30pm**, we will <u>live-stream</u> the recitation of the **Holy Rosary** and invite you all to pray with us from home.
- On Thursdays, following the Divine Liturgy until 9:00pm, we will <u>live-stream</u> Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and invite you all to pray with us from home.
- On **Fridays, at 7:00pm**, we will *live-stream* **Stations of the Cross/Benediction of the Cross** and invite you to pray with us from home.
- The church will be opened daily from 9am-4pm for private prayer (entrance will be through the Chapel side-door).

We encourage anyone who is feeling ill, exhibiting flu-like symptoms, or considered part of a vulnerable health population to **stay home** in consideration of their health and that of others.

We encourage you to continue to follow the updates and guidelines put forth by the **Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)**

When Watching Liturgy from Home

We encourage you to treat Liturgy with the same reverence that you would at the church.

Eliminate distractions during the Liturgy by silencing/turning off your cell phone.

Gather the family to pray together.

Stand/sit at the same times you would during an in-person Liturgy (especially during the proclamation of the Gospel and Consecration)

Listen attentively and prayerfully

Prayer for Spiritual Communion

During the time of communion, recite the following in place of receiving physical communion:

O Divine Ocean of Mercy and Compassion, be with us in our time of trial and difficulties. Today I make an act of spiritual communion with you, the Life-Giving Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. At this time I am not able to receive the sacred body and blood of my Lord, God and Savior Jesus Christ, but I choose to live in union with him and in the unity of the Holy Spirit. I offer my day, my daily life, my joys and sorrows to you, for those around me, and for the whole world. Be with us O life-giving Triune God, for we know that nothing in this world has power over us. O Lover of all people, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

نظرًا لتفاقم الأزمة الصحيّة التي خلّفها وباء فيروس كورونا وحرصًا منّا على تطبيق القرار الصادر عن ولاية ماساتشوستس بتاريخ 15/3/2020 وانسجامًا مع نداءات صاحب السيادة المطران غريغوري منصور السامي الإحترام وانطلاقًا من واجبنا الإنساني بالحد من إنتشار هذا الوباء نُحيطكم علمًا بالتدابير الراعويّة التالية علمًا أنّها لأسباب وقائيّة وبصورة مؤقّتة:

أوّلًا: بقرار من راعي الأبرشيّة المطران غريغوري منصور السامي الإحترام يُفسّح استثنائيًا وبصورة مؤقتة ولأسباب وقائيّة من فريضة الإشتراك بالقدّاس الإلهي يوم الأحد.

ثانيًا: بالرغم من هذا التفسيح، يعوّض عنه بالصلاة البيتيّة في العائلة والإشتراك بالقدّاس الإلهي عبر وسائل التواصل الإجتماعي.

ثالثًا: تعليق جميع اللّقاءات والنّشاطات الخاصة بمنظمات الرعيّة من ضمنها السهرات الإنجيليّة.

رابعًا: سيقوم كهنة الرعيّة بإقامة الذبيحة الإلهيّة اليوميّة بحسب المواعيد الإعتياديّة إذ أنّ عدد المشاركين لا يتخطّى ال 25. خامسًا: قداسات أيّام السبوت والآحاد وجميع الصلوات (راجع بند 6) سوف تُنقل مباشرة من خلال رابط خاص موجود على كافة صفحات التواصل الإجتماعي الخاصة بالرعيّة.

EPISTLE READING - Timothy 5,24-25 . 6,1-5

Brothers and sisters, The sins of some people are conspicuous and precede them to judgement, while the sins of others follow them there. So also good works are conspicuous; and even when they are not, they cannot remain hidden. Let all who are under the yoke of slavery regard their masters as worthy of all honor, so that the name of God and the teaching may not be blasphemed. Those who have believing masters must not be disrespectful to them on the ground that they are members of the church; rather they must serve them all the more, since those who benefit by their service are believers and beloved. Teach and urge these duties. Whoever teaches otherwise and does not agree with the sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ and the teaching that is in accordance with godliness, is conceited, understanding nothing, and has a morbid craving for controversy and for disputes about words. From these come envy, dissension, slander, base suspicions, and wrangling among those who are depraved in mind and bereft of the truth, imagining that godliness is a means of gain.

GOSPEL READING - Saint Mark 2,1-12.

When Jesus returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home. So many gathered around that there was no longer room for them, not even in front of the door; and he was speaking the word to them. Then some people came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. And when they could not bring him to Jesus because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him; and after having dug through it, they let down the mat on which the paralytic lay. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, 'Son, your sins are forgiven.' Now some of the scribes were sitting there, questioning in their hearts, 'Why does this fellow speak in this way? It is blasphemy! Who can forgive sins but God alone?' At once Jesus perceived in his spirit that they were discussing these questions among themselves; and he said to them, 'Why do you raise such questions in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, "Your sins are forgiven", or to say, "Stand up and take your mat and walk"? But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins' he said to the paralytic 'I say to you, stand up, take your mat and go to your home.' And he stood up, and immediately took the mat and went out before all of them; so that they were all amazed and glorified God, saying, 'We have never seen anything like this!'
