- 6. You can then complete any or all the fields and click submit.
- 7. If desired, you may send obituary notice, special documents, letters, receipts etc. to rectory@stanthonylawrence.org and we will attach that to your loved one's record.

Guidelines For Public Liturgies During Pandemic - Capacity 50%

Should I come to Liturgy?

Anyone who is ill, symptomatic, or has been exposed to someone else with the coronavirus within 14 days cannot enter the church.

What should I do if I cannot come to Liturgy?

We will continue to livestream our Liturgies on our Facebook page.

How will we be kept safe when we come to Liturgy?

All pews are wiped down with disinfectant; and all Qurbono Books are removed; and all surfaces used frequently (restroom facilities, door handles, etc.) are sanitized before each service.

Everyone attending Liturgy is obligated to wear a mask or other facial covering. The only exception during Liturgy is when receiving Holy Communion. You'll be asked to observe social distancing – staying at least six feet from people not in your household. You can drop your donation in a stationary basket, or continue to use the online provided by your parish.

Can we receive Holy Communion?

Yes, but only the Most Precious Body and only by hand.

What do we need to keep in mind as we leave Liturgy?


Please leave Liturgy together as a household, wearing your masks or other facial covering and observing six feet of distance from others.

"Their eyes were prevented from recognizing him"

You have heard, dearly beloved, that the Lord appeared to two disciples while they were walking on the road. They were talking about him, even though they did not believe. He did not show them an appearance which they could recognize, but the Lord behaved before the eyes of their bodies in accord with what was going on inwardly before the eyes of their hearts. Within themselves they were both loving and doubting; and the Lord was present to them out. outwardly, but did not show them who he was. He manifested his presence to them as they talked about him, but hid the appearance by which they would recognize him on account of their doubts. He did indeed talk with them, reproving the hardness of their understanding and opening to them the mysteries of holy scripture concerning himself: and yet, because as an object of faith he was still a stranger to their hearts, he made a pretense of going on farther... The perfect Truth did nothing deceitful; he was only manifesting himself to them materially as they were thinking of him.

It had to be shown whether those who did not as yet love him as God were at least able to love him as a stranger. Since those with whom Truth was walking couldn't be alien to charity, they invited him, a stranger, to be their guest. But why do I say they invited him, when it is written that they compelled him? We must surely infer from this example that strangers are not only to be invited to be guests but even forcibly persuaded.

They set the table, brought food, and recognized in the breaking of the bread the God they did not know as he explained the sacred scriptures. They were not enlightened by hearing God's commandments, but by putting them into practice.



Gospel: Saint John 21: 1-14

After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way.

Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin, Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. Simon Peter said to them, 'I am going fishing.' They said to him, 'We will go with you.' They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to them, 'Children, you have no fish, have you?' They answered him, 'No.' He said to them, 'Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some.' So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, 'It is the Lord!' When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the lake. But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards off. When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on it, and bread. Jesus said to them, 'Bring some of the fish that you have just caught.' So Simon Peter went aboard and hauled the net ashore, full of large fish, a hundred and fifty-three of them; and though there were so many, the net was not torn. Jesus said to them, 'Come and have breakfast.' Now none of the disciples dared to ask him, 'Who are you?' because they knew it was the Lord. Jesus came and took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish. This was now the third time that Jesus appeared to the disciples after he was raised from the dead.

بَعْدَ ذَلِك، ظَهَرَ يَسُوعُ لِتَلامِيذِهِ مَرَّةً أُخْرَى عَلَى بُحَيْرَةِ طَبَرَيَّة، وهكَذَا ظَهَر: كَانَ سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُس، وتُومَا المُلَقَّبُ بِٱلتَّوْأَم، ونَتَنَائِيلُ الَّذي مِنْ قَانَا الجَلِيل، وٱبْنَا زَبَدَى، وتِلْمِيذَانِ آخَرَانِ مِنْ تَلامِيذِ يَسُوع، مُجْتَمِعِينَ مَعًا. قَالَ لَهُم سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُس: »أَنَا ذَاهِبٌ أَصْطَادُ سَمَكًا . ﴿قَالُوا لَهُ: ﴾ ونَحْنُ أَيْضًا نَأْتِي مَعَكَ . ﴿فَخَرَجُوا وَرَكِبُوا السَّفِينَة، فَمَا أَصَابُوا في تِلْكَ اللَّيْلَةِ شَيْئًا. ولَمَّا طَلَعَ الفَجْر، وَقَفَ يَسُوعُ عَلى الشَّاطِئ، ولكِنَّ التَّلامِيذَ لَمْ يَعْلَمُوا أَنَّهُ يَسُوع. فَقَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: »يَا فِتْيَان، أَمَا عِنْدَكُم قَلِيلٌ مِنَ السَّمَك؟ . ﴿أَجَابُوه: »لا! . ﴿فَقَالَ لَهُم: »أَلْقُوا الشَّبَكةَ إلى يَمِينِ السَّفِينَةِ تَجِدُوا . ﴿ وَأَلْقَوْهَا، فَمَا قَدِرُوا عَلَى ٱجْتِذَابِهَا مِنْ كَثْرَةِ السَّمَك. فَقَالَ ذلِكَ التِّلْمِيذُ الَّذي كَانَ يَسُوعُ يُحِبُّهُ لِبُطْرُس: > إِنَّهُ الرَّبِّ . ﴿ فَلَمَّا سَمِعَ سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُسُ أَنَّهُ الرَّبِّ، إِتَّزَرَ بِتَوْبِهِ، لأَنَّهُ كَانَ عُرْيَانًا، وأَلْقَى بِنَفْسِهِ في البُحَيْرَة. أَمَّا التَّلامِيذُ الآخَرُونَ فَجَاؤُوا بِٱلسَّفِينَة، وهُمْ يَسْحَبُونَ الشَّبَكَةَ المَمْلُوءَةَ سَمَكًا، ومَا كَانُوا بَعِيدِينَ عَنِ البَرِّ إلاَّ نَحْوَ مِئتَى ذِرَاع. ولَمَّا نَزَلُوا إلى البَرّ، رَأُوا جَمْرًا، وسَمَكًا عَلَى الجَمْر، وخُبْزًا. قَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: >هَاتُوا مِنَ السَّمَكِ الَّذي أَصَبْتُمُوهُ الآن . «فَصَعِدَ سِمْعَانُ بُطْرُسُ إلى السَّفِينَة، وجَذَبَ الشَّبَكَةَ إلى البَرّ، وهِيَ مَمْلُوءَةٌ سَمَكًا كَبِيرًا، مِئَةً وتَلاثًا وخَمْسِين. ومَعَ هذه الكَثْرَةِ لَمْ تَتَمَزَّق الشَّبَكَة. قَالَ لَهُم يَسُوع: »هَلْمُّوا تَغَدَّوا . «ولَمْ يَجْرُؤْ أَحَدٌ مِنَ التَّلامِيذِ أَنْ يَسْأَلُهُ: >>مَنْ أَنْت؟ «، لأَنَّهُم عَلِمُوا أَنَّهُ الرَّبِّ. وتَقَدَّمَ يَسُوعُ وأَخَذَ الخُبْزَ ونَاوَلَهُم. ثُمَّ فَعَلَ كَذَلِكَ بِٱلسَّمَك. هذه مَرَّةٌ ثَالِثَةٌ ظَهَرَ فيهَا يَسُوعُ لِلتَّلامِيذِ بَعْدَ أَنْ قَامَ مِنْ بَيْنِ الأَمْوَات.

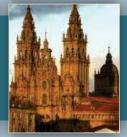
