*In Two Hours, '2 Hearts'***Unpacks Two Love Stories and a Tragedy**

The movie is based on the real-life story of Jorge and Leslie Bacardi, known for their family's Caribbean-imported Bacardi Rum.

The two unique love stories, from two different parts of the world and two different eras, are knitted together in Silver Lion Films' romantic drama *2 Hearts*, which opens in theaters this weekend. The crisis that draws the two families together is unexpected, but their strength as they seek to do God's will is exemplary.

I talked recently with Lance Hool, the film's director, and with Mexican actor Adan Canto (*X-Men: Days of Future Past*; *Designated Survivor*), who plays the role of Jorge. The film, Hool said, is about hope and faith and trust in God. "I didn't know if it was going to work," Hool said, "because people in Hollywood don't make films like this... I had a great feeling that it was necessary to do it — it's almost as though a light shone on me, and I thought "This has got to be done!"

.....Hool hoped that moviegoers would leave the theater having felt the greatness and the pain of love, and beyond that, that they would emerge with a feeling of hope.

..... True, abiding love is evident in *2 Hearts*, and it warms the viewer's own heart. At the same time, the film is candid in its embrace of suffering; and it reminds the viewer that one person's tragedy, however painful, can bring joy and peace to so many others.

## CEMETERY RULES & GUIDELINES

*Several inquiries have been made regarding Cemetery flowers and plants at the graves. In order for us to maintain a respectable resting place for our loved ones, guidelines are set in place and available on our website for your reference.*

### **Planting Policy**

The planting policy of St. Anthony Maronite Cemetery is as follows. Flowers only (either annuals or perennials) may be planted at the base of a monument with the following stipulations:

- 1. The flowerbed may be no wider than the width of the monument base and must come out from the monument base no more than eight (8) inches.*
- 2. No shrubs, trees, or bushes may be planted in the planting bed.*
- 3. Ornaments, such as plastic decorations, pinwheels, animal figurines, balloons, etc. are not allowed.*
- 4. No bed covering, such as mulch or stones, etc. may be added to the planting bed.*
- 5. Upkeep of the planted materials is the sole responsibility of the person who has planted the flowers.*
- 6. St. Anthony Cemetery bears no responsibility for upkeep nor does it assume liability for damage, theft, or vandalism with regard to the plantings or the planting bed.*
- 7. If plantings and planting bed are not maintained, or if inappropriate materials appear in the bed, St. Anthony Cemetery reserves the right to remove any dead plants or inappropriate materials.*
- 8. On occasion, the cemetery maintenance staff may remove plantings to accommodate a burial or other activity. Cemetery staff cannot replace plantings.*

Note that plantings cannot be placed on a Flat Marker Lot, but only on an upright Monument Lot.

Funeral pre-arrangements are available and recommended with guarantees of no increase in cemetery charges at the time of interment.

Pre-Arrangement Funds are placed in a separate account and are withdrawn at the time of the interment. An interest free Time-Payment Plan is available for your convenience.

## PARISH COMMUNICATION –COVID 19 NEW GUIDELINES

Dear Parishioners of St. Anthony Maronite Church,

Let us first and foremost “give thanks to the Lord for he is good, and his mercy endures forever” (Ps. 107:1). Proximally, the last year and half has been one of trial and tribulation for each individual, for each family, for each community, here and throughout the entire world. It appears, however, that we are nearing the end of this pandemic and recent announcements from the Government encourage us to look ahead and to begin putting this pandemic behind us.

Governor Baker and his administration recently announced that the Commonwealth is on track to meet the goal of vaccinating 4.1 million residents by the first week of June, and as a result of this all remaining COVID-19 restrictions will be lifted effective May 29. This includes the current face covering order which will be replaced with a face covering *advisory* instead. Governor Baker will also end the State of Emergency on June 15. The Commonwealth leads the nation in vaccinating residents, with 75% of adults receiving at least one dose. To date, over 4 million residents have received a first dose, with 3.2 million fully vaccinated.

This encouraging news requires us at St. Anthony to begin taking steps to return our community to pre-pandemic days. Thus, **as of May 29**:

- Church pews will no longer be blocked off
- Liturgy (Qorbono) books will be returned to the pews for use
- Communion by intinction (under both species received on the tongue) will be available
- Face masks will no longer be required inside the Church

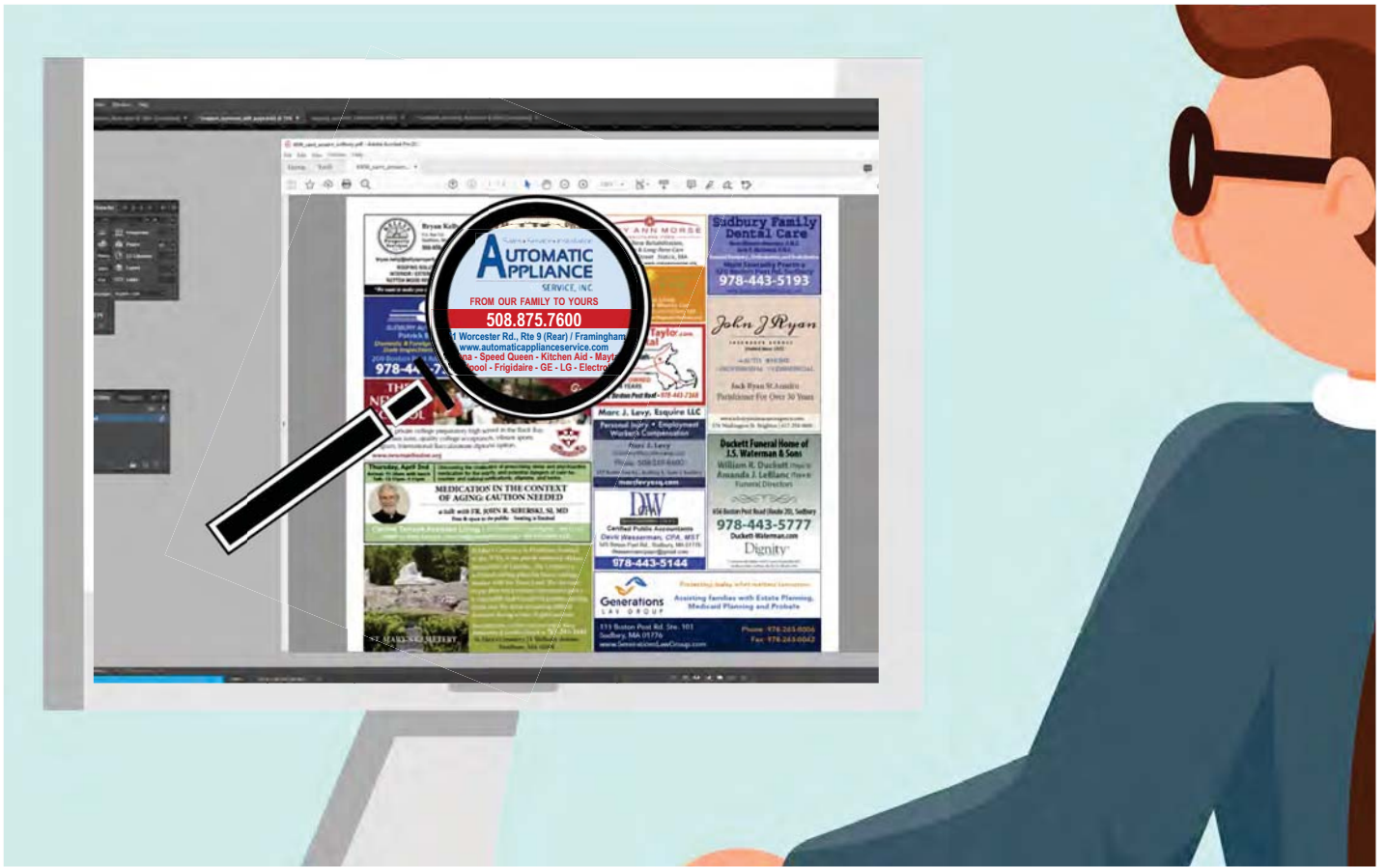
We understand that it will take some time for everyone to feel comfortable again, so **we will continue to temporarily**:

- keep the QR Codes on the pews for those that wish to access the Liturgical texts without handling a Qorbono book
- make available communion received by hand
- recommend that non-vaccinated individuals to wear face masks and to continue distancing in most settings (per the Commonwealth of Massachusetts’ new face-mask advisory)
- live-stream Divine Liturgies on Facebook

Please take note that **as of September 6**, weekend Divine Liturgies will no longer be live-streamed on Facebook as this is a Holy Day of Obligation and dispensation from this will be lifted. We do plan to live-stream Weekday Liturgies however, but details on this will follow.

Your comfort and safety have always been our top concerns, but as our State, and States across the Country, are re-opening with a desire to return to a state of normalcy, it is our responsibility to do the same as a Community of Faith and House of God.

We sincerely look forward to seeing our pews filled again, coming together as one faith-family to praise God for all the blessings he continues to bestow upon us.

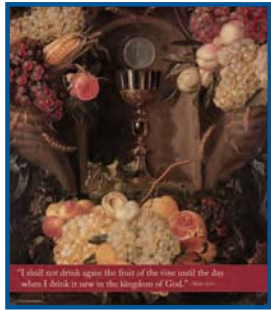
