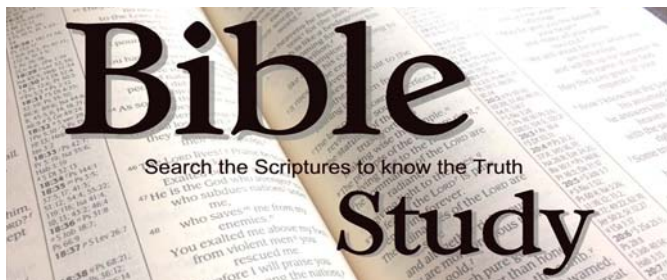

Feast of the Presentation of Christ in the Temple, or Purification of the Blessed Virgin, is being observed today (Feb. 2) by Christians around the world. While it is customary for Christians in some countries to remove their Christmas decorations on Twelfth Night (Epiphany Eve), those in other Christian countries historically remove them on Candlemas. On Candlemas, many Christians (especially Anglicans, Methodists, Lutherans, Orthodox and Roman Catholics) also take their candles to their local church, where they are blessed and then used for the rest of the year.

The Feast of the Presentation is one of the oldest feasts of the Christian church, celebrated since the 4th century AD in Jerusalem.

In Israel, the Law of Moses considered the first-born male child to belong to God. The same law considered the mother "unclean" after giving birth. For forty days she could not go out or touch anything sacred. To "ransom" the child and "cleanse" the mother, a visit to temple was required, which involved a sacrificial offering of a lamb and a dove. If the family had limited means, the lamb could be exchanged for a dove. Thus, two doves were sufficient to fulfill the precept, shares America Needs Fatima.

Forty days after the birth of Jesus, St. Joseph again helped his virgin wife onto the donkey only now she carried the creator of the universe in her arms. Slowly they made their way to Jerusalem to comply

with the Mosaic Law. In their case, there was really no need for "ransom" or "cleansing," Jesus being God, and Mary being a virgin before, during and after the birth of her divine Son.

Yet, before the eyes of men, unaware of these circumstances, the holy family wished to give an example of humility and obedience by submitting to the age-old mandate. The fact that St. Joseph offered two doves is evidence of their poverty.

According to the Mosaic law, a mother who had given birth to a man-child was considered unclean for seven days; moreover she was to remain three and thirty days "in the blood of her purification"; for a maid-child the time which excluded the mother from sanctuary was even doubled, according to [Catholic News World](#). When the time (40 or 80 days) was over the mother was to "bring to the temple a lamb for a holocaust and a young pigeon or turtle dove for sin"; if she was not able to offer a lamb, she was to take two turtle doves or two pigeons; the priest prayed for her and so she was cleansed. (Leviticus 12:2-8)

Forty days after the birth of Christ Mary complied with this precept of the law, she redeemed her first-born from the temple (Numbers 18:15), and was purified by the prayer of Simeon the just, in the presence of Anna the prophetess (Luke 2:22). No doubt this event, the first solemn introduction of Christ into the house of God, was in the earliest times celebrated in the Church of Jerusalem.

But the feast then had no proper name; it was simply called the fortieth day after Epiphany. This latter circumstance proves that in Jerusalem Epiphany was then the feast of Christ's birth.

From Jerusalem the feast of the fortieth day spread over the entire Church and later on was kept on the second of February, since within the last 25 years of the fourth century the Roman feast of Christ's nativity (Dec. 25) was introduced.

يوحنا 4:7-5, 9-26

فأتى إلى مدينة من السامرة يُقال لها سوحار، على مقربة من الأرض التي أعطاه يعقوب لابنيه يوسف، وفيها نبع يعقوب. وكان يسوع قد تعب من المسير، فجلس عند النبع، وكانت الساعة نحو الظهر. وجاءت امرأة من السامرة لتسقي ماء، فقال لها يسوع: «أعطيني لأشرب؟» فقالت له المرأة السامرية: «كيف تطلب مني أن تشرب، وأنت يهودي، وأنا امرأة سامرية؟». «قالت هذا، لأن اليهود لا يخالطون السامريين. أجاب يسوع وقال لها: «لو كنت تعرفين عطية الله، ومن القائل لك: أعطيني لأشرب، لطلبت أنت منه فأعطاك ماءً حيّاً». «قالت له المرأة: «يا سيّد، لا دلو معك، والبرّ عميقة، فمن أين لك الماء الحي؟ هل أنت أعظم من أبينا يعقوب، الذي أعطانا هذه البرّ، ومنها شرب هو وبثوه وماشيئته؟». «أجاب يسوع وقال لها: «كل من يشرب من هذا الماء يعطش من جديد. أمّا من يشرب من الماء الذي أعطيه أنا إياه، فلن يعطش إلى الأبد، بل الماء الذي أعطيه إياه يصير فيه نبع ماء يتفجّر حياةً أبديةً». «قالت له المرأة: «أعطني هذا الماء، حتّى لا أعطش، ولا أعود إلى هنا لتسقي». «قال لها: «إذهبي، وأدعي زوجك، وعودي إلى هنا». «أجابت المرأة وقالت له: «لا زوج لي». «قال لها يسوع: «حسنًا قلت: لا زوج لي. فقد كان لك خمسة أزواج، والذي لك الآن ليس هو زوجك. صدقت في ما قلت». «قالت له المرأة: «يا سيّد، أرى أنك نبيّ. أبأؤنا سجدوا في هذا الجبل، وأنتم تقولون: إنّ المكان الذي فيه يجب السجود هو في أورشليم». «قال لها يسوع: «صدقيني، يا امرأة. تأتي ساعة، فيها تسجدون للآب، لا في هذا الجبل، ولا في أورشليم. أنتم تسجدون لما لا تعلمون، ونحن نسجد لما نعلم، لأنّ الخلاص هو من اليهود. ولكن تأتي ساعة، وهي الآن، فيها الساجدون الحقيقيون يسجدون للآب بالروح والحق. فعلى مثال هؤلاء يريد الآب الساجدين له. الله روح، وعلى الساجدين له أن يسجدوا بالروح والحق». «قالت له المرأة: «أنا أعلم أنّ مسيحاً، أي المسيح، أت؛ وعندما يأتي فهو يُخبرنا بكلّ شيء». «قال لها يسوع: «أنا هو، أنا المتكلّم معك.»»

Epistle & Gospel: Fourth Sunday After Epiphany

Galatians 3:23-29

Do you not know, brothers and sisters for I am speaking to those who know the law that the law is binding on a person only during that person's lifetime? Thus a married woman is bound by the law to her husband as long as he lives; but if her husband dies, she is discharged from the law concerning the husband. Accordingly, she will be called an adulteress if she lives with another man while her husband is alive. But if her husband dies, she is free from that law, and if she marries another man, she is not an adulteress. In the same way, my friends, you have died to the law through the body of Christ, so that you may belong to another, to him who has been raised from the dead in order that we may bear fruit for God. While we were living in the flesh, our sinful passions, aroused by the law, were at work in our members to bear fruit for death. But now we are discharged from the law, dead to that which held us captive, so that we are slaves not under the old written code but in the new life of the Spirit.

John 4:7-5, 9-26

So he came to a Samaritan city called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob had given to his son Joseph. Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired out by his journey, was sitting by the well. It was about noon. A Samaritan woman came to draw water, and Jesus said to her, 'Give me a drink'. The Samaritan woman said to him, 'How is it that you, a Jew, ask a drink of me, a woman of Samaria?' (Jews do not share things in common with Samaritans.) Jesus answered her, 'If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, "Give me a drink", you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water.' The woman said to him, 'Sir, you have no bucket, and the well is deep. Where do you get that living water? Are you greater than our ancestor Jacob, who gave us the well, and with his sons and his flocks drank from it?' Jesus said to her, 'Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, but those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty. The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life.' The woman said to him, 'Sir, give me this water, so that I may never be thirsty or have to keep coming here to draw water.' Jesus said to her, 'Go, call your husband, and come back.' The woman answered him, 'I have no husband.' Jesus said to her, 'You are right in saying, "I have no husband"; for you have had five husbands, and the one you have now is not your husband. What you have said is true!' The woman said to him, 'Sir, I see that you are a prophet. Our ancestors worshipped on this mountain, but you say that the place where people must worship is in Jerusalem.' Jesus said to her, 'Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem. You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews. But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father seeks such as these to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.' The woman said to him, 'I know that Messiah is coming' (who is called Christ). 'When he comes, he will proclaim all things to us.' Jesus said to her, 'I am he, the one who is speaking to you.'

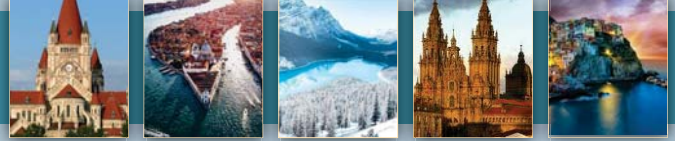
