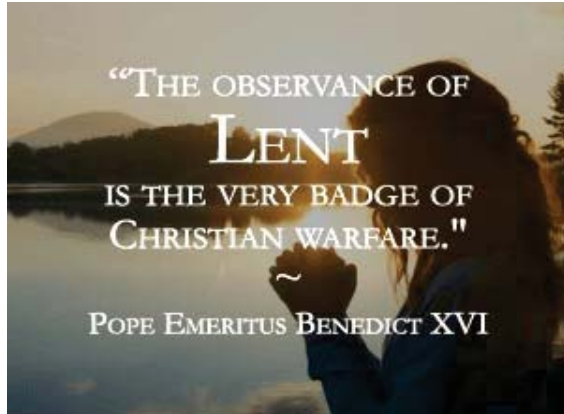

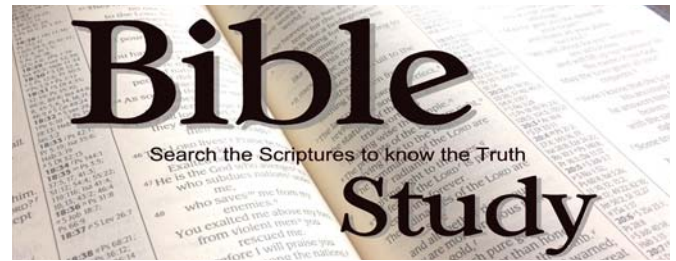

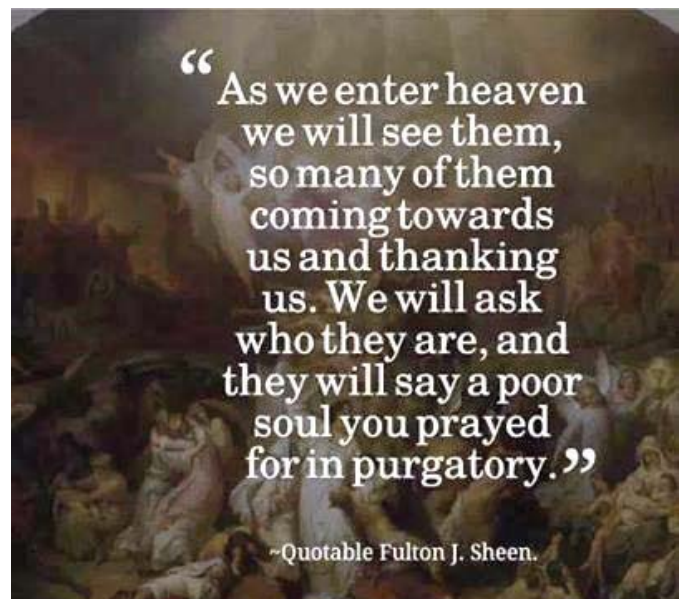

GIVE UP GOSSIP FOR LENT AND FOR LIFE

Changes in our lives are difficult and it's probable we will slip up. But resolve again to reject gossip. Here are a few tips I have found helpful when rooting out this vice:

1. Always assume the best. We are quick to jump to conclusions only to be embarrassed when we find out we were wrong. Assume the best about a person or situation until proven otherwise.

2. Think before you speak. Submit your comment to the following criteria: Is it true? Do I need to share this information? Will it cause people to think poorly of someone else? Is it better left unsaid?

3. Examine your motivation. Why do I want to share this information? Is it because it will lift me up and put someone else down? Will I somehow become favored over the person I'm talking about?

4. Think about all the conversations you had. Identify if you said anything you regret sharing about other people. If there is someone, offer a prayer for them. Ask God to help them in whatever struggles they are facing. Ask God to heal any hurt or damage you may have caused to that person's name or reputation. It might be good to say an Act of Contrition and then ask God's help to say only what he wants you to say the next day. This is a great spiritual exercise for the end of the day.

5. Do something about it. The next time someone in your family, workplace, social circle, or parish begins to talk badly about someone — act. Stop the conversation. Walk away. (Someone did that to me once and it spoke volumes.) You can also interject a positive comment about the person. Resolve with your friends to have more positive conversation and ask them to hold each other accountable.

The season of Lent is an opportunity for spiritual growth, especially in virtue. Instead of giving up chocolate or coffee this Lent, do something that will be beneficial for everybody — give up gossip! And make sure it's not only for Lent, but for the rest of your life.

Epistle & Gospel: Sunday of the Faithful Departed

1 Thessalonians 5,1-11.

Concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you do not need to have anything written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. When they say, 'There is peace and security', then sudden destruction will come upon them, as labour pains come upon a pregnant woman, and there will be no escape! But you, beloved, are not in darkness, for that day to surprise you like a thief; for you are all children of light and children of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. So then, let us not fall asleep as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober; for those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.

Luke 16,19-31.

'There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. And at his gate lay a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who longed to satisfy his hunger with what fell from the rich man's table; even the dogs would come and lick his sores. The poor man died and was carried away by the angels to be with Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried. In Hades, where he was being tormented, he looked up and saw Abraham far away with Lazarus by his side. He called out, "Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am in agony in these flames." But Abraham said, "Child, remember that during your lifetime you received your good things, and Lazarus in like manner evil things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in agony. Besides all this, between you and us a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who might want to pass from here to you cannot do so, and no one can cross from there to us." He said, "Then, father, I beg you to send him to my father's house for I have five brothers that he may warn them, so that they will not also come into this place of torment." Abraham replied, "They have Moses and the prophets; they should listen to them." He said, "No, father Abraham; but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent." He said to him, "If they do not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced even if someone rises from the dead." '

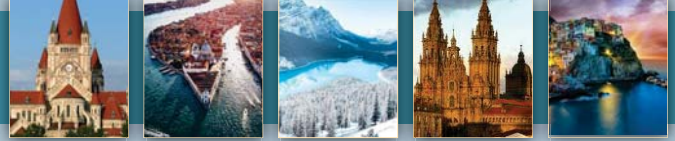
