Father Joseph Antoine Abi-Saad, 68, was born on December 15, 1955, in Bsous, Lebanon. He passed away on August 19, 2024 surrounded by his family. Father Joseph accepted his vocation to the priesthood at age 61 years old and was ordained a Maronite priest for the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn on June 11, 2016, at Our Lady's Maronite Church in Bsous, Lebanon.

His first assignment was as Parochial Vicar of Saint Anthony Church, in MEET OUR DEACONS: Lawrence, MA, while also serving the pastoral needs of the faithful at Saint George Church, in Dover, NH. In 2018, he was appointed Administrator of Saint Sharbel Church, in Newtown Square, PA, and in 2022 as Administrator of Saint Theresa Church, in Brockton, MA.

Father Joseph embodied selflessness. From a very young age, he devoted himself to the needs of his family and friends, becoming the person everyone turned to for support and guidance. His hospitality and unwavering faith made him a pillar in the lives of those who knew him. He had a special talent for making people feel comfortable and valued and each conversation turned into a place to share his wisdom. His coffee gatherings were testament to him being an encyclopedia of knowledge, not just about philosophical and theological matters, but also to his deep understanding of coffee.

Father Joseph's influence impacted everyone who shared life with him and left a long-lasting impression on all who knew him. He was an inspiration to all and it was a privilege to know him.

Father Joseph was predeceased by his mother, Renée Al Tayyar Abi-Saad of Bsous, Lebanon, his father, Antoine Youssef Abi-Saad of Bsous, Lebanon, his sister Lisette Antoine Abi-Saad Sfeir of Bsous, Lebanon, his brother Jack Antoine Abi-Saad of Bsous, Lebanon. He is survived by his sister, Josette Antoine Abi-Saad of Bsous, Lebanon and his brother in law Henri Antoine Sfeir of Jounieh, Lebanon.

Father Joseph also leaves behind many friends whom he called family, especially his life-long friends Camil Abdelnour, Gaby, whose late wife was Marlene Maroun Abdelnour, and two special girls who were precious in his eyes: Regina and Gabrielle Abdelnour.

Our hope is in the resurrection of the Lord and the promise of eternal life, which we believe Fr. Joseph has been rewarded for being the good and faithful servant that he was.

Fifteenth Sunday of Pentecost: Repentance of a Sinful Woman

Book of Micah 7:7-9. 18-20

But as for me, I will look to the LORD, I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me. Do not rejoice over me, O my enemy; when I fall, I shall rise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD will be a light to me. I must bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he takes my side and executes judgement for me. He will bring me out to the light; I shall see his vindication. Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over the transgression of the remnant of your possession? He does not retain his anger for ever, because he delights in showing clemency. He will again have compassion upon us; he will tread our iniquities under foot. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea. You will show faithfulness to Jacob and unswerving loyalty to Abraham, as you have sworn to our ancestors from the days of old.

First Letter to the Thessalonians 1: 1-10

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace. We always give thanks to God for all of you and mention you in our prayers, constantly remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labour of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. For we know, brothers and sisters beloved by God, that he has chosen you, because our message of the gospel came to you not in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of people we proved to be among you for your sake. And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for in spite of persecution you received the word with joy inspired by the Holy Spirit, so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia. For the word of the Lord has sounded forth from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but in every place where your faith in God has become known, so that we have no need to speak about it. For the people of those regions report about us what kind of welcome we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols, to serve a living and true God, and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath that is coming.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 7: 36-50

One of the Pharisees asked Jesus to eat with him, and he went into the Pharisee's house and took his place at the table. And a woman in the city, who was a sinner, having learned that he was eating in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster jar of ointment. She stood behind him at his feet, weeping, and began to bathe his feet with her tears and to dry them with her hair. Then she continued kissing his feet and anointing them with the ointment. Now when the Pharisee who had invited him saw it, he said to himself, 'If this man were a prophet, he would have known who and what kind of woman this is who is touching him that she is a sinner.' Jesus spoke up and said to him, 'Simon, I have something to say to you.' 'Teacher,' he replied, 'speak.' 'A certain creditor had two debtors; one owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. When they could not pay, he cancelled the debts for both of them. Now which of them will love him more?' Simon answered, 'I suppose the one for whom he cancelled the greater debt.' And Jesus said to him, 'You have judged rightly.' Then turning towards the woman, he said to Simon, 'Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave me no water for my feet, but she has bathed my feet with her tears and dried them with her hair. You gave me no kiss, but from the time I came in she has not stopped kissing my feet. You did not anoint my head with oil, but she has anointed my feet with ointment. Therefore, I tell you, her sins, which were many, have been forgiven; hence she has shown great love. But the one to whom little is forgiven, loves little.' Then he said to her, 'Your sins are forgiven.' But those who were at the table with him began to say among themselves, 'Who is this who even forgives sins?' And he said to the woman, 'Your faith has saved you; go in peace.'
