#### "Living as Citizens of Heaven: Our Mission in Christ"

#### Dear Parishioners,

We often focus on the Gospel during the Sunday liturgy and tend to overlook the Epistle. This week, I would like to share with you some thoughts on the Epistle of Saint Paul to the Philippians (3:17-21, 4:1). Paul speaks with deep concern about those who live as "enemies of the cross of Christ." This may seem like a harsh term, but Paul is not simply talking about those who actively oppose the Christian faith. Rather, he is referring to those whose lives are focused on earthly things—people whose priorities are shaped by self-indulgence, materialism, and the pursuit of immediate gratification. Paul warns us that these individuals "glory in their shame" and "their minds are set on earthly things." In other words, they place their trust in things that do not last, whether it's wealth, power, or physical pleasure. Their "god is the belly," meaning their desires and appetites control them, rather than the will of God. Paul grieves for them because their end is destruction, and their way of life leads away from Christ. But St. Paul also offers us a way forward. He reminds us that, as Christians, "our citizenship is in heaven." This means that our values, our hopes, and our actions should be guided by a higher purpose—by our relationship with Jesus Christ. Instead of being driven by temporary desires, we are called to focus on eternal things. How do we avoid becoming enemies of the cross? First, by recognizing that we are not defined by what we possess or achieve in this world. Our mission is to live as citizens of heaven, reflecting Christ's love and mercy in all that we do. This requires daily commitment to prayer, to serving others, and to growing in holiness. As St. John Vianney once said, "The saints did not all begin well, but they ended well." This reminds us that, no matter our past or the temptations we face, our focus must be on growing in faith and love. We can always turn back to Christ and recommit ourselves to following Him with full hearts. Our mission is clear: we are to witness to the truth of the Gospel, to be lights in the world. We do this not by withdrawing from the world, but by living in it with a heart set on God. We accomplish this mission by living out our faith with integrity, loving our neighbors, and standing firm in the Lord, as Paul urges. Let us reflect on how we can embody this mission more fully in our own lives, ensuring that our citizenship in heaven is evident through the choices we make and the love we show to others.



## Third Sunday of The Cross: False Messiahs and Coming of the Son of Man

## Book of Daniel 7:9-14

As I watched, thrones were set in place, and an Ancient One took his throne; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames, and its wheels were burning fire. A stream of fire issued and flowed out from his presence. A thousand, thousand served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood attending him. The court sat in judgement, and the books were opened. I watched then because of the noise of the arrogant words that the horn was speaking. And as I watched, the beast was put to death, and its body destroyed and given over to be burned with fire. As for the rest of the beasts, their dominion was taken away, but their lives were prolonged for a season and a time. As I watched in the night visions, I saw one like a human being coming with the clouds of heaven. And he came to the Ancient One and was presented before him. To him was given dominion and glory and kingship, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, and his kingship is one that shall never be destroyed.

#### First Letter to the Philippians 3: 17-21. 4:1

Brothers and sisters, join in imitating me, and observe those who live according to the example you have in us. For many live as enemies of the cross of Christ; I have often told you of them, and now I tell you even with tears. Their end is destruction; their god is the belly; and their glory is in their shame; their minds are set on earthly things. But our citizenship is in heaven, and it is from there that we are expecting a Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. He will transform the body of our humiliation so that it may be conformed to the body of his glory, by the power that also enables him to make all things subject to himself. Therefore, my brothers and sisters, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, my beloved.

### Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 24: 23-31

If anyone says to you, "Look! Here is the Messiah!" or "There he is!" do not believe it. For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and produce great signs and omens, to lead astray, if possible, even the elect. Take note, I have told you beforehand. So, if they say to you, "Look! He is in the wilderness", do not go out. If they say, "Look! He is in the inner rooms", do not believe it. For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes as far as the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather. 'Immediately after the suffering of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of heaven will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven" with power and great glory. And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.
