"Working Out Our Salvation with Faith and Vigilance"

Dear Parishioners,

In this week's readings, we are reminded of the profound responsibility each of us has in working out our salvation. Saint Paul, in his letter to the Philippians, encourages us to "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling" (Philippians 2:12). This call to action is not meant to instill fear in a negative sense but rather a deep reverence for God's grace and a recognition of the seriousness of our spiritual journey.

But how do we *work out* our salvation?

1. By remaining vigilant, spiritually prepared, and attentive to their faith like the wise bridesmaids. They keep their "lamps" full—full of grace, good works, and faithfulness—so that when the Lord comes, they are ready to meet Him.
2. By participating actively. Our salvation is not a passive gift; it requires active participation, vigilance, and perseverance. Pope Benedict XVI reminds us of the importance of this vigilance when he says: "Faith is not a theory, a philosophy, or an idea; it is an encounter. A faith encounter with the living God who is our Father, who loves us, and who in His Son has become flesh, who is present in the Holy Spirit, who is present in the Church." We are called not to a superficial or passive faith, but to a vibrant and **personal encounter with Christ** that transforms our lives and keeps us spiritually alert, ready for His return.
3. With hope and joy. The call to work for our salvation is not one of anxiety, but of **hope and joy**. Saint Paul rejoices, even as he offers his life as a "libation," because he knows that his labor for the faith is meaningful. In this spirit, Pope Benedict XVI says: "We are not some casual and meaningless product of evolution. Each of us is the result of a thought of God. Each of us is willed, each of us is loved, each of us is necessary." Knowing this, we can approach our faith with joy and dedication, confident that our efforts are not in vain. Every act of kindness, every prayer, every moment of forgiveness, and every decision to follow Christ is part of our journey toward eternal life.

Brothers and sisters, let us ask ourselves: **Are our lamps full? Are we spiritually prepared? Are we participating actively in our salvation? Are we living the real joy of and hope?**

May the Lord bless us and keep us vigilant in faith, filled with His grace, and always ready to meet Him.



Fifth Sunday of The Cross: Parable of the Ten Bridesmaids

Song of Songs 5: 2-8

I slept, but my heart was awake. Listen! my beloved is knocking. 'Open to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my perfect one; for my head is wet with dew, my locks with the drops of the night.' I had put off my garment; how could I put it on again? I had bathed my feet; how could I soil them? My beloved thrust his hand into the opening, and my inmost being yearned for him. I arose to open to my beloved, and my hands dripped with myrrh, my fingers with liquid myrrh, upon the handles of the bolt. I opened to my beloved, but my beloved had turned and was gone. My soul failed me when he spoke. I sought him, but did not find him; I called him, but he gave no answer. Making their rounds in the city the sentinels found me; they beat me, they wounded me, they took away my mantle, those sentinels of the walls. I adjure you, O daughters of Jerusalem, if you find my beloved, tell him this: I am faint with love.

Letter to the Philippians 2: 12-18

Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed me, not only in my presence, but much more now in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who is at work in you, enabling you both to will and to work for his good pleasure. Do all things without murmuring and arguing, so that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, in which you shine like stars in the world. It is by your holding fast to the word of life that I can boast on the day of Christ that I did not run in vain or labour in vain. But even if I am being poured out as a libation over the sacrifice and the offering of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you and in the same way you also must be glad and rejoice with me.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 25: 1-13

'Then the kingdom of heaven will be like this. Ten bridesmaids took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. When the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them; but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps. As the bridegroom was delayed, all of them became drowsy and slept. But at midnight there was a shout, "Look! Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him." Then all those bridesmaids got up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish said to the wise, "Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out." But the wise replied, "No! there will not be enough for you and for us; you had better go to the dealers and buy some for yourselves." And while they went to buy it, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went with him into the wedding banquet; and the door was shut. Later the other bridesmaids came also, saying, "Lord, lord, open to us." But he replied, "Truly I tell you, I do not know you." Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.
