"The Silent Journey of Trust and Hope"

Dear Parishioners,

In the Gospel of Luke for the Sunday of Zechariah, we encounter a powerful moment when Zechariah, upon hearing the angel Gabriel's promise of a son, questions how this could happen given his and his wife Elizabeth's old age. As a result of his doubt, Zechariah is struck silent. What seems at first like a sanction—being unable to speak—reveals itself as an opportunity for reflection, prayer, and trust in God's timing.

God's timing is often mysterious and challenges us to deepen our faith. Zechariah and Elizabeth had likely prayed for years for a child, but when their prayers were finally answered, Zechariah struggled to believe. How often do we also question God's timing, especially when His promises seem delayed or impossible? In these moments, God invites us to wait patiently, trusting that His plan unfolds in ways we may not understand but that always aim at our ultimate good. Zechariah's silence is more than a punishment; it is an invitation to grow in faith. Without the ability to speak, he is drawn into a period of contemplation, giving him time to ponder the angel's words, to observe God's unfolding work, and to cultivate a deeper trust. In this silence, Zechariah's doubt is transformed into faith, and by the time his voice is restored, he is ready to proclaim the greatness of God with a renewed heart. For us, too, periods of silence or waiting can be gifts if we allow them to be. When answers to our prayers are delayed or when we face situations that test our faith, we can see these as opportunities to draw closer to God. Silence invites us to listen more carefully, to open our hearts, and to trust that God's promises will be fulfilled in their perfect time. So, Zechariah teaches us that God's timing is always purposeful. Let us embrace these moments of waiting and silence, not as sanctions but as sacred times to think, pray, and deepen our faith, knowing that God's plan is unfolding and that His promises will be fulfilled in ways far beyond our understanding.

As parishioners at Saint Anthony, preparing for the Christmas season and journeying together in this Year of Hope, let us see ourselves as *Pilgrims of Hope*, knowing that God walks with us in each moment, especially in times of waiting. We learn to trust that, like Zechariah, our moments of silence and reflection can be times of grace. Let us approach Christmas with renewed hope, confident that Christ's light shines through all our waiting, bringing peace and joy to each of us.

Sunday of the Announcement to Zechariah

Book of Genesis 17: 15-22

God said to Abraham, 'As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her Sarai, but Sarah shall be her name. I will bless her, and moreover I will give you a son by her. I will bless her, and she shall give rise to nations; kings of peoples shall come from her.' Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said to himself, 'Can a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old? Can Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a child?' And Abraham said to God, 'O that Ishmael might live in your sight!' God said, 'No, but your wife Sarah shall bear you a son, and you shall name him Isaac. I will establish my covenant with him as an everlasting covenant for his offspring after him. As for Ishmael, I have heard you; I will bless him and make him fruitful and exceedingly numerous; he shall be the father of twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation. But my covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah shall bear to you at this season next year.' And when he had finished talking with him, God went up from Abraham.

Letter to the Romans 4: 13-25

The promise that he would inherit the world did not come to Abraham or to his descendants through the law but through the righteousness of faith. If it is the adherents of the law who are to be the heirs, faith is null and the promise is void. For the law brings wrath; but where there is no law, neither is there violation. For this reason it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed to all his descendants, not only to the adherents of the law but also to those who share the faith of Abraham (for he is the father of all of us, as it is written, 'I have made you the father of many nations') in the presence of the God in whom he believed, who gives life to the dead and calls into existence the things that do not exist. Hoping against hope, he believed that he would become 'the father of many nations', according to what was said, 'So numerous shall your descendants be.' He did not weaken in faith when he considered his own body, which was already as good as dead (for he was about a hundred years old), or when he considered the barrenness of Sarah's womb. No distrust made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God, being fully convinced that God was able to do what he had promised. Therefore his faith 'was reckoned to him as righteousness.' Now the words, 'it was reckoned to him', were written not for his sake alone, but for ours also. It will be reckoned to us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead, who was handed over to death for our trespasses and was raised for our justification.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 1: 1-25

Since many have undertaken to set down an orderly account of the events that have been fulfilled among us, just as they were handed on to us by those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and servants of the word, I too decided, after investigating everything carefully from the very first, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may know the truth concerning the things about which you have been instructed. In the days of King Herod of Judea, there was a priest named Zechariah, who belonged to the priestly order of Abijah. His wife was a descendant of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth. Both of them were righteous before God, living blamelessly according to all the commandments and regulations of the Lord. But they had no children, because Elizabeth was barren, and both were getting on in years. Once when he was serving as priest before God and his section was on duty, he was chosen by lot, according to the custom of the priesthood, to enter the sanctuary of the Lord and offer incense. Now at the time of the incense-offering, the whole assembly of the people was praying outside. Then there appeared to him an angel of the Lord, standing at the right side of the altar of incense. When Zechariah saw him, he was terrified; and fear overwhelmed him. But the angel said to him, 'Do not be afraid, Zechariah, for your prayer has been heard. Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you will name him John. You will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth, for he will be great in the sight of the Lord. He must never drink wine or strong drink; even before his birth he will be filled with the Holy Spirit. He will turn many of the people of Israel to the Lord their God. With the spirit and power of Elijah he will go before him, to turn the hearts of parents to their children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the righteous, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.' Zechariah said to the angel, 'How will I know that this is so? For I am an old man, and my wife is getting on in years.' The angel replied, 'I am Gabriel. I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to bring you this good news. But now, because you did not believe my words, which will be fulfilled in their time, you will become mute, unable to speak, until the day these things occur.' Meanwhile, the people were waiting for Zechariah, and wondered at his delay in the sanctuary. When he did come out, he could not speak to them, and they realized that he had seen a vision in the sanctuary. He kept motioning to them and remained unable to speak. When his time of service was ended, he went to his home. After those days his wife Elizabeth conceived, and for five months she remained in seclusion. She said, 'This is what the Lord has done for me when he looked favorably on me and took away the disgrace I have endured among my people.'
