PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

As we continue our Advent journey, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception (December 8) shines as a profound moment of grace and hope. This feast celebrates the extraordinary gift granted to the Virgin Mary, who was preserved free from original sin from the very moment of her conception.

The History of the Feast

The belief in Mary's Immaculate Conception has deep roots in the Church's tradition. Early Church Fathers, including Saint Ephrem and Saint Augustine, spoke of Mary's purity and unique role in salvation history. The doctrine was formally defined in 1854 by Pope Pius IX in the Apostolic Constitution *Ineffabilis Deus*, which proclaimed:

"The Blessed Virgin Mary, in the first instance of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege granted by Almighty God, in view of the merits of Jesus Christ, the Savior of the human race, was preserved free from all stain of original sin."

This declaration confirmed what had been celebrated in the Church for centuries, recognizing Mary as the new Eve, whose obedience and purity made her the perfect vessel for the Incarnation of Christ.

Mary's Example for Our Advent Journey

Mary's Immaculate Conception reminds us of God's divine plan and His call for us to live in holiness. As Mary embraced her role in salvation history with complete trust, we too are invited to surrender our hearts to God's will, especially as we prepare for the birth of His Son. During this Advent season, let us:

- 1. **Ponder Mary's Example:** Take time in prayer to reflect on her openness to God's grace.
- 2. **Deepen Our Spiritual Preparation:** Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation and make space for Christ in our hearts.
- 3. Live in Hope and Joy: As part of this Jubilee Year of Hope, strive to bring Christ's light to those around you.

The lights of Christmas that surround us are a reflection of the true Light, Jesus Christ, who is the reason for our celebration. May we, like Mary, be filled with grace as we welcome Him into our lives.

Sunday of the Birth of St John the Baptist - Feast of the Immaculate Conception

1st book of Samuel 1:9-11. 19b-23

After they had eaten and drunk at Shiloh, Hannah rose and presented herself before the LORD. Now Eli the priest was sitting on the seat beside the doorpost of the temple of the LORD. She was deeply distressed and prayed to the LORD, and wept bitterly. She made this vow: 'O LORD of hosts, if only you will look on the misery of your servant, and remember me, and not forget your servant, but will give to your servant a male child, then I will set him before you as a nazirite until the day of his death. He shall drink neither wine nor intoxicants, They rose early in the morning and worshipped before the LORD; then they went back to their house at Ramah. Elkanah knew his wife Hannah, and the LORD remembered her. In due time Hannah conceived and bore a son. She named him Samuel, for she said, 'I have asked him of the LORD.' The man Elkanah and all his household went up to offer to the LORD the yearly sacrifice, and to pay his vow. But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, 'As soon as the child is weaned, I will bring him, that he may appear in the presence of the LORD, and remain there for ever; I will offer him as a nazirite for all time.'

Letter to the Hebrews 7: 11-17

If, then, perfection came through the Levitical priesthood for under it the people received the law, what need would there still have been for another priest to rise according to the order of Melchizedek, and not be designated according to the order of Aaron? When there is a change of priesthood, there is necessarily a change of law as well. Now he of whom these things are said belonged to a different tribe, of which no member ever officiated at the altar. It is clear that our Lord arose from Judah, and in regard to that tribe Moses said nothing about priests. It is even more obvious if another priest is raised up after the likeness of Melchizedek, who has become so, not by a law expressed in a commandment concerning physical descent but by the power of a life that cannot be destroyed. For it is testified: "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 11:27-32

While he was speaking, a woman from the crowd called out and said to him, "Blessed is the womb that carried you and the breasts at which you nursed." He replied, "Rather, blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe It. "While still more people gathered in the crowd, he said, "This generation is an evil generation; it seeks a sign, but no sign will be given it, except the sign of Jonah. Just as Jonah became a sign to the Ninevites, so will the Son of Man be to this generation. At the judgment, the queen of the south will rise with the men of this generation and she will condemn them, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, and there is something greater than Solomon here. At the judgment, the men of Nineveh will arise with this generation and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and there is something greater than Jonah here."
