The Importance of Daily Mass

Dear Parishioners,

After the joyful Christmas Season, and all the festivities in our church, I would like to take a moment to share with you the importance and the beauty of the daily mass. The daily Mass holds immense importance in the life of the Catholic Church, serving as a profound encounter with Christ and a **source of spiritual nourishment**. The Church teaches that the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (Lumen Gentium, 11), and daily Mass offers an opportunity to immerse oneself in this divine mystery more frequently, fostering deeper communion with God and the community.

Daily Mass is not merely a repetition of Sunday worship but a **unique encounter** where we partake in the sacrifice of Christ. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that in the Eucharist, "Christ gives us the very body which he gave up for us on the cross" (CCC 1365). Attending daily Mass allows us to grow in holiness, be strengthened in our spiritual journey, and receive the grace needed to live out our faith in daily life. It provides a moment of pause and reflection amid the busyness of life, offering peace, encouragement, and renewal. Attending daily Mass also **deepens our relationship with Scripture**. Each liturgy includes readings from the Bible, allowing us to meditate on God's Word and see its relevance in our lives. As Pope Benedict XVI highlighted, "The liturgy is the privileged setting in which God speaks to us in the midst of our lives" (Verbum Domini, 52).

Moreover, daily Mass fosters a sense of **community and commitment**. It allows parishioners to come together regularly, not only to worship but also to support and encourage one another in faith. In this sacred assembly, we remember and pray for each other, for the sick among our parishioners and friends, and for peace in our hearts, homes, and the whole world. What a beautiful way to start our day, surrendering to God's will and renewing daily our faith in Him.

At Saint Anthony Church, the daily Mass schedule reflects the diversity and the richness of our parish community. **Monday and Wednesday Masses in Arabic, Tuesday and Thursday Masses in English at 9:00 am.**

Dear parishioners, I encourage everyone who can attend the daily mass, to do not hesitate, because the daily Mass is a treasure, it draws us closer to God, nourishes our souls, and unites us as a community of faith. Whether in Arabic or English, morning Mass at Saint Anthony Church is a beautiful opportunity to encounter Christ and embrace His call to holiness every day.

First Sunday after Epiphany

Book of Isaiah 40: 6-11

A voice says, 'Cry out!' And I said, 'What shall I cry?' All people are grass, their constancy is like the flower of the field. The grass withers, the flower fades, when the breath of the LORD blows upon it; surely the people are grass. The grass withers, the flower fades; but the word of our God will stand for ever. Get you up to a high mountain, O Zion, herald of good tidings; lift up your voice with strength, O Jerusalem, herald of good tidings, lift it up, do not fear; say to the cities of Judah, 'Here is your God!' See, the Lord GOD comes with might, and his arm rules for him; his reward is with him, and his recompense before him. He will feed his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms, and carry them in his bosom, and gently lead the mother sheep.

Second Letter to the Corinthians 10: 1-11

I myself, Paul, appeal to you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ I who am humble when face to face with you, but bold towards you when I am away! I ask that when I am present I need not show boldness by daring to oppose those who think we are acting according to human standards. Indeed, we live as human beings, but we do not wage war according to human standards; for the weapons of our warfare are not merely human, but they have divine power to destroy strongholds. We destroy arguments and every proud obstacle raised up against the knowledge of God, and we take every thought captive to obey Christ. We are ready to punish every disobedience when your obedience is complete. Look at what is before your eyes. If you are confident that you belong to Christ, remind yourself of this, that just as you belong to Christ, so also do we. Now, even if I boast a little too much of our authority, which the Lord gave for building you up and not for tearing you down, I will not be ashamed of it. I do not want to seem as though I am trying to frighten you with my letters. For they say, 'His letters are weighty and strong, but his bodily presence is weak, and his speech contemptible.' Let such people understand that what we say by letter when absent, we will also do when present.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint John 1: 29 - 34

The next day he saw Jesus coming towards him and declared, 'Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, "After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me." I myself did not know him; but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel.' And John testified, 'I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, "He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit." And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Son of God.'

رسالة القديس بولس الثانية إلى أهل كورنتس 10: 1-11

يا إخوتي، أنا بولس نفسي أناشدكم بوداعة المسيح وحلمه، أنا المتواضع بينكم عندما أكون حاضراً، والجريء عليكم عندما أكون غائباً. وأرجو ألا أجبر عند حضورتي أن أكون جريئاً، بالنقّة التي لي بكم، والتي أنوي أن أجروها بها على الذين يحسبون أننا نسلك كأناس جسديين. أجل، إننا نحيا في الجسد، ولكننا لا نحارب كأناس جسديين؛ لأن أسلحة جهادنا ليست جسديّة، بل هي قاذرة بالله على هدم الحصون المنيعة؛ فإننا نهدم الأفكار الخاطئة، وكل شموخ يرتفع ضد معرفة الله، ونأسر كل فكر لطاعة المسيح. ونحن مستعدون أن نعاقب كل عصيان، متى كملت طاعتكم. إنكم تحكمون على المظاهر! إن كان أحد واثقاً بنفسه أنه للمسيح، فليفكر في نفسه أنه كما هو للمسيح كذلك نحن أيضاً. فأنا لا أخجل إن بالعت بعض المبالغة في الاقتحار بالسُلطان الذي وهبه الرب لنا لبنيانكم لا لهدمكم. ولا أريد أن أظهر كأني أخوفكم برسائلي؛ لأن بعضاً منكم يقولون: «رسائله شديدة اللهجة وقوية، أما حضوره الشخصي فهزيل، وكلامه سخيّف!». «فليعلم مثل هذا القائل أننا كما نحن بالكلام في الرسائل، عندما نكون غائبين، كذلك نحن أيضاً بالفعل، عندما نكون حاضرين.

إنجيل القديس يوحنا 1: 29-34

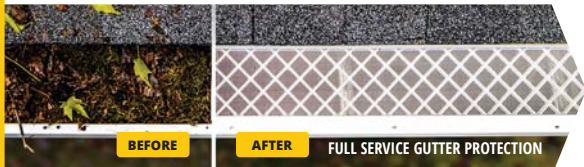
