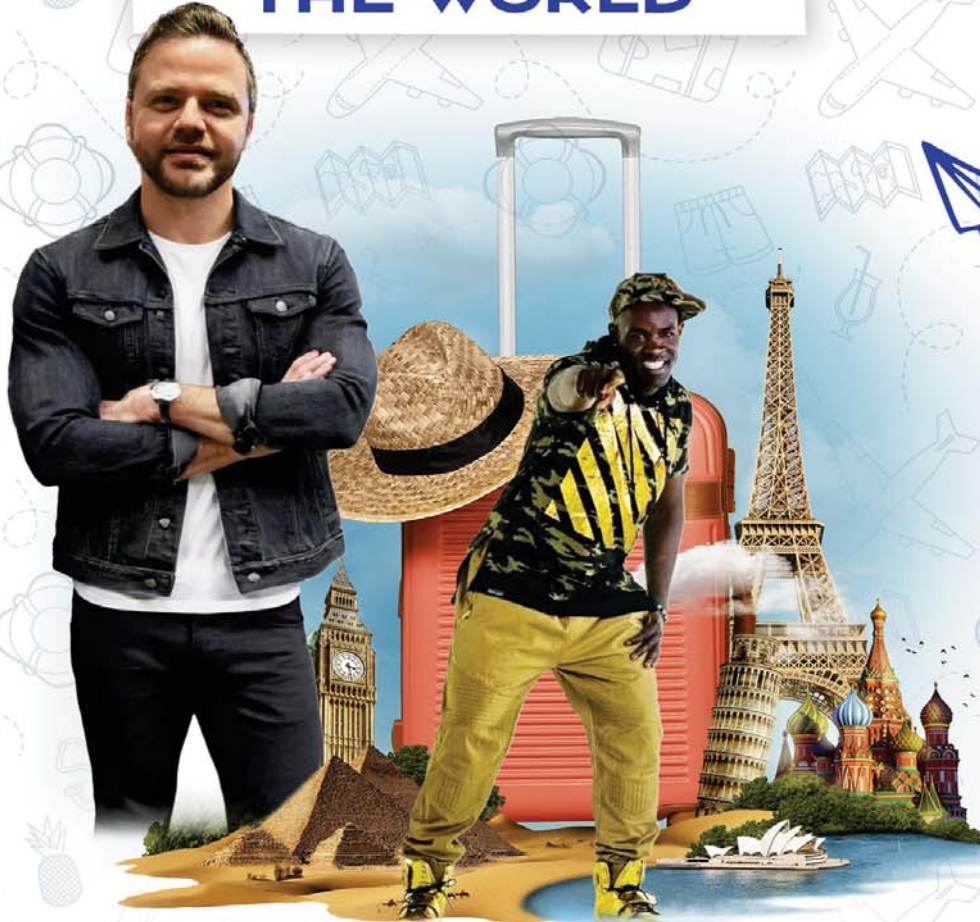

Lenten Season: A Season of Hope for Pilgrims of Hope

Dear Parishioners,

As we embark on the sacred journey of Lent, we are reminded that this is a **season of hope**—a time to renew our faith, deepen our prayer, and grow in love for God and one another. We are called to be **pilgrims of hope**, walking together toward the joy of Easter, trusting in God’s promises and His boundless mercy.

This year, our Lenten schedule is made to help us fully immerse ourselves in this season of Hope. Save the Dates:

- **Ash Monday, March 3:** We begin our Lenten journey with the **Liturgy & Blessing of the Ashes** at 9:00 AM and 6:00 PM. The ashes remind us of our mortality and call us to repentance and renewal.
- **“The Shrine Thursday” Every Thursday:** Join us for **Liturgy at 9:00 AM**, followed by **Exposition of the Eucharist (Adoration)** from 9:30 AM to 7:00 PM. The day will conclude with **Prayers, Hymns, Procession, and the Final Blessing.**
- **Every Friday:** We will gather at 6:00 PM for the **Stations of the Cross**, a homily, and the **Adoration of the Cross**, reflecting on how to become pilgrims of hope in our daily life, and how to overcome all the obstacles that prevent us from living in hope.
- **“Saints, Witnesses of Hope” Saturday & Sunday, March 29-30:** A special **Relics Exhibition** will be held. On Saturday, it will run from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM, with a talk at 5:00 PM. On Sunday, it will be open from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM, with a talk at 12:00 PM.
- **Saturday, April 5: The Regional MYA Spiritual Retreat** will take place from 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM, offering a time of reflection and spiritual growth for our youth and young adults.
- **“Live Love Lent”** This project invites each of us—adults, youth, and children—to actively participate in the spirit of giving and sharing, embodying the true essence of Lent.” Everyone can receive a Lenten box with a unique number to collect charitable donations throughout Lent. The boxes will be distributed on the **Sunday of Cana** and collected by **Hosana Sunday** or Holy Week. The amounts corresponding to each box number (without names) will be published for transparency. This initiative is for everyone, adults, youth, and children, to share the joy of giving.
- **Friday, April 11, “Candlelight of Hope”**, a Lenten recital to inspire reflection and prayer as we prepare for Holy Week.

Let us walk together as pilgrims of hope, embracing prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. May this Lenten season transform our hearts and bring us closer to the love of Christ.

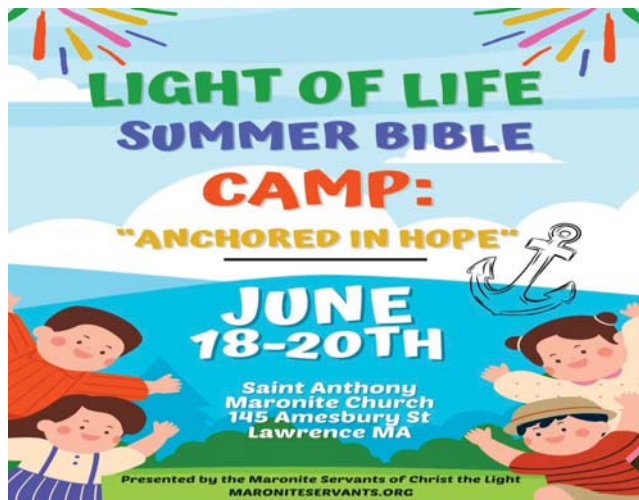

Sunday of the Faithful Departed

Book of Ezekiel 37:1-10

The hand of the LORD came upon me, and he brought me out by the spirit of the LORD and set me down in the middle of a valley; it was full of bones. He led me all round them; there were very many lying in the valley, and they were very dry. He said to me, 'Mortal, can these bones live?' I answered, 'O Lord GOD, you know.' Then he said to me, 'Prophecy to these bones, and say to them: O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD. Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones: I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live. I will lay sinews on you, and will cause flesh to come upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and you shall live; and you shall know that I am the LORD.' So I prophesied as I had been commanded; and as I prophesied, suddenly there was a noise, a rattling, and the bones came together, bone to its bone. I looked, and there were sinews on them, and flesh had come upon them, and skin had covered them; but there was no breath in them. Then he said to me, 'Prophecy to the breath, prophecy, mortal, and say to the breath: Thus says the Lord GOD: Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.' I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood on their feet, a vast multitude.

First Letter to the Thessalonians 5:1-11

Concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you do not need to have anything written to you. For you yourselves know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. When they say, 'There is peace and security', then sudden destruction will come upon them, as labour pains come upon a pregnant woman, and there will be no escape! But you, beloved, are not in darkness, for that day to surprise you like a thief; for you are all children of light and children of the day; we are not of the night or of darkness. So then, let us not fall asleep as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober; for those who sleep sleep at night, and those who are drunk get drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has destined us not for wrath but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us, so that whether we are awake or asleep we may live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build up each other, as indeed you are doing.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Luke 16:19-31

"There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and who feasted sumptuously every day. And at his gate lay a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores, who longed to satisfy his hunger with what fell from the rich man's table; even the dogs would come and lick his sores. The poor man died and was carried away by the angels to be with Abraham. The rich man also died and was buried. In Hades, where he was being tormented, he looked up and saw Abraham far away with Lazarus by his side. He called out, "Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am in agony in these flames." But Abraham said, "Child, remember that during your lifetime you received your good things, and Lazarus in like manner evil things; but now he is comforted here, and you are in agony. Besides all this, between you and us a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who might want to pass from here to you cannot do so, and no one can cross from there to us." He said, "Then, father, I beg you to send him to my father's house for I have five brothers that he may warn them, so that they will not also come into this place of torment." Abraham replied, "They have Moses and the prophets; they should listen to them." He said, "No, father Abraham; but if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent." He said to him, "If they do not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be convinced even if someone rises from the dead." "

وكانت علي يد الرب فأخرجني بروح الرب ووضعني في وسط السهل وهو مُمتلئ عظامًا، وأمرني عليها من حولها، فإذا هي كثيرة جدًا على وجه السهل، وإذا بها يابسة جدًا. فقال لي: «يا ابن الإنسان، أترى تحيا هذه العظام؟» «فقلت: «أيها السيد الرب، أنت تعلم. «فقال لي: «تنبأ على هذه العظام وقل لها: أيُّها العظام اليابسة اسمعي كلمة الرب. هكذا قال السيد الرب لهذه العظام: هاءنذا أدخل فيك روحًا فتحيين. أجعل عليك عصبًا وأنشئ عليك لحمًا وأسط عليك جلدًا وأجعل فيك روحًا فتحيين وتعلمين أنني أنا الرب. «فتنبأت كما أمرت. فكان صوت عند تنبؤي، وإذ بارتعاش، فتقاربت العظام كل عظم إلى عظمه. ونظرت فإذا بالعصب واللحم قد نشأ عليها، وبسط عليها الجلد من فوق ولم يكن بها روح. فقال الرب لي: «تنبأ للروح، تنبأ يا ابن الإنسان وقل للروح: هكذا قال السيد الرب: هلم أيُّها الروح من الرياح الأربع، وهب في هؤلاء المفقولين فحيوا. «فتنبأت كما أمرني، فدخل فيهم الروح، فعاثوا وقاموا على أقدامهم جيشًا عظيمًا جدًا جدًا.

رسالة القديس بولس الأولى إلى أهل تسالونيقي 5: 1-11

يا إخوتي، أمّا الأزمنة والأوقات، أيُّها الإخوة، فلا حاجة بكم أن يكتب إليكم في شأنها؛ لأنكم تعلمون جيدًا أن يوم الرب يأتي كالسارق ليلاً. فحين يقولون: سلامٌ وأمنٌ! حينئذ يدهمهم الهلاك وهم المخاص للخبلي، ولا يفطنون. أمّا أنتم، أيُّها الإخوة، فلستم في ظلمة ليفاجئكم ذلك اليوم كالسارق. فأنتم كلُّكم أبناء النور، وأبناء النهار؛ ولستنا أبناء الليل ولا أبناء الظلمة. إذا فلا ننم كسائر الناس، بل لنسهر ونصح؛ لأن الذين ينامون ففي الليل ينامون، والذين يسكرون ففي الليل يسكرون. أمّا نحن أبناء النهار، فلنصح لابسين ذرع الإيمان والمحبة، وواضعين خوذة رجاء الخلاص. فإن الله لم يجعلنا للغضب، بل لإخراز الخلاص بربنا يسوع المسيح، الذي مات من أجلنا، لنحيا معه ساهرين كُنّا أم نائمين. فلذلك شجعوا بعضكم بعضًا، وليبن الواحد الآخر، كما أنتم فاعلون.

انجيل القديس لوقا 16: 19-31

قال الرب يسوع: «كان رجلٌ غنيٌ يلبس الأرجوان والكثان الناعم، ويتنعم كل يوم بأفخر الولائم. وكان رجلٌ مسكينٌ اسمه لعازرٌ مطروحًا عند بابه، تكسوه القروح. وكان يشتهي أن يشبع من الفتات المتساقط من مائدة الغني، غير أن الكلاب كانت تأتي فتلحس قروحه. ومات المسكين فحملته الملائكة إلى حضن إبراهيم. ثم مات الغني ودفن. ورفع الغني عينيه، وهو في الجحيم يقاسي العذاب، فرأى إبراهيم من بعيد، ولعازر في حضنه. فنادى وقال: يا أبت إبراهيم، ارحمني وأرسل لعازر ليبل طرف إصبعه بماء ويبرد لساني، لأنني متوجع في هذا اللهب. فقال إبراهيم: يا ابني، تذكر أنك نلت خيراتك في حياتك، ولعازر نال البلاء. والآن هو يتعزى هنا، وأنت تتوجع. ومع هذا كله، فإن بيننا وبينكم هوة عظيمة ثابتة، حتى إن الذين يريدون أن يجتازوا من هنا إليكم لا يستطيعون، ولا من هناك أن يعبروا إلينا. فقال الغني: أسألك إذا، يا أبت، أن ترسل لعازر إلى بيت أبي، فإن لي خمسة إخوة، ليشهد لهم، كي لا يأتوا هم أيضًا إلى مكان العذاب هذا. فقال إبراهيم: عندهم موسى والأنبياء، فليسمعوا لهم. فقال: لا، يا أبت إبراهيم، ولكن إذا مضى إليهم واحدٌ من الأموات يتوبون. فقال له إبراهيم: إن كانوا لا يسمعون لموسى والأنبياء، فإنهم، ولو قام واحدٌ من الأموات، لن يقتنعوا!!»

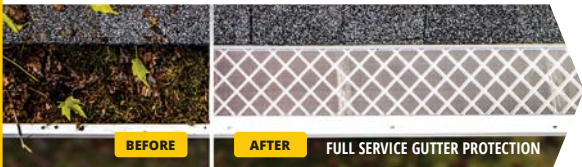
