

Three Weeks of Commemorations Before Lent in the Maronite Church Dear Parishioners,

As we prepare to enter the sacred season of Lent, the Maronite Church dedicates the three weeks before Ash Monday to the commemoration of those who have gone before us in faith. These weeks are a time of reflection, gratitude, and prayer, reminding us of the journey we all share toward eternal life. Through these commemorations, we acknowledge the importance of those who have served, lived righteously, and remained faithful to God.

1. The Commemoration of the Priests

The first week is dedicated to the priests, bishops, and all clergy who have served as shepherds of the Church. Through their ministry, they have been instruments of God's grace, preaching the Word, celebrating the sacraments, and guiding the faithful. We pray for those who have passed away, especially all the priests who served in Saint Anthony since it was established in 1901, asking God to reward them for their service and to keep watching over us from Heaven.

2. The Commemoration of the Righteous and the Just

The second week honors all the righteous and just, those who have lived holy lives, following the will of God. This includes the saints, martyrs, and all those who have exemplified faith, love, and charity. The Gospel passage for this week is Matthew 25:31-46, where Jesus speaks of the Final Judgment—separating the sheep from the goats based on acts of mercy and love. This passage calls us to examine our lives and ask: Are we serving Christ in the poor, the sick, the hungry, and the suffering? It is a reminder that holiness is not just about reciting prayers but also about how we love and serve others.

3. The Commemoration of the Faithful Departed

The final week before Lent is dedicated to all the faithful departed—our loved ones who have gone before us in faith. The Maronite Church consecrates a whole week to pray for the dead, asking for God's mercy so that they may share in the eternal joy of His Kingdom. we believe in the power of intercessory prayer for the departed, because love is infinite, and this connection will never finish, it transforms into a spiritual relationship through prayer, sacrifices, and the Eucharist. This commemoration reminds us of our mortality and encourages us to live each day in preparation for eternal life, and on day we will meet with our loved ones and live eternally in Heaven.

As Saint John Paul II said: "Never, ever give up on hope, never doubt, never tire, and never become discouraged. Be not afraid." May these weeks be a time of prayer, reflection, and gratitude, preparing our hearts to embark on the Lenten journey as "Pilgrims of Hope" toward Easter.



Sunday of the Righteous and the Just

Book of Wisdom 5:1, 3-6, 8,15-16

Then shall the righteous one with great assurance confront his oppressors who set at nought his labors. They shall say among themselves, rueful and groaning through anguish of spirit: "This is the one whom once we held as a laughingstock and as a type for mockery, fools that we were! His life we accounted madness, and death dishonored. See how he is accounted among the heavenly beings; how his lot is with the holy ones! We, then, have strayed from the way of truth, and the light of righteousness did not shine for us, and the sun did not rise for us. What did our pride avail us? What have wealth and its boastfulness afforded us? But the righteous live forever, and in the LORD is their recompense, and the thought of them is with the Most High. Therefore shall they receive the splendid crown, the beautiful diadem, from the hand of the LORD, For he will shelter them with his right hand, and protect them with his arm.

Letter to the Hebrews 12:18-24

You have not come to something that can be touched, a blazing fire, and darkness, and gloom, and a tempest, and the sound of a trumpet, and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that not another word be spoken to them. (For they could not endure the order that was given, 'If even an animal touches the mountain, it shall be stoned to death.' Indeed, so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, 'I tremble with fear.') But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Matthew 25:31-46

'When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left. Then the king will say to those at his right hand, "Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me." Then the righteous will answer him, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?" And the king will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." Then he will say to those at his left hand, "You that are accursed, depart from me into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not give me clothing, sick and in prison and you did not visit me." Then they also will answer, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?" Then he will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me." And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.'


