



Sin, New Manifestation of Leprosy

Dear Parishioners,

The Gospel of Mark 1:35-43 recounts the powerful story of Jesus healing a leper, a moment that reveals not only His divine authority but also His boundless compassion. In this passage, a man afflicted with leprosy approaches Jesus, kneels before Him, and says, "If you wish, you can make me clean." Moved with pity, Jesus touches him and says, "I do will it. Be made clean." Immediately, the leprosy leaves him, and he is healed. This miracle offers a profound reflection on the nature of sin and the healing power of Christ.

Leprosy, in biblical times, was not only a physical illness but also a symbol of sin. In our actual times, sin is worse than leprosy and it's a new Manifestation of it. It disfigures the soul, corrupting our relationship with God and others. Just as leprosy isolates the afflicted from society, sin separates us from the community of believers and from God Himself. Sin is a spiritual disease that, if left untreated, spreads and destroys the beauty of our souls. It kills our spiritual life, leaving us in a state of emptiness and despair. As Saint Augustine famously said, "Sin is to the soul what a wound is to the body; it weakens, disfigures, and, if not healed, leads to death."

Moreover, just as leprosy was contagious and could harm others, sin has a ripple effect, contaminating those around us. Our actions, words, and attitudes influenced by sin can lead others astray, damaging relationships and creating division. The leper in the Gospel was an outcast, forced to live apart from society. Similarly, sin alienates us from others, breeding mistrust, resentment, and loneliness. It disrupts the harmony God intends for His children. Yet, the healing of the leper reminds us that no one is beyond the reach of Christ's mercy. Jesus did not hesitate to touch the leper, even though doing so made Him ritually unclean. This act demonstrates His willingness to enter into our brokenness, to take on our impurities, and to restore us to wholeness. In the same way, Jesus desires to cleanse us from the leprosy of sin. Through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, He touches our souls, heals our wounds, and restores us to communion with God and others.

The leper's words, "If you wish, you can make me clean," are an invitation for us to approach Jesus with the same humility and faith. We must acknowledge our sins, confess them, and trust in His power to heal us. As Saint John Chrysostom teaches, "Confession is a medicine for the soul, a remedy for sin, a gift of God's mercy." Let us not allow the leprosy of sin to fester in our hearts. Instead, let us turn to Jesus, the Divine Physician, who longs to make us clean and whole once more.



Second Sunday of Great Lent: Healing of the Leper

2nd book of Kings 5:1-3, 9-14

Naaman, commander of the army of the king of Aram, was a great man and in high favour with his master, because by him the LORD had given victory to Aram. The man, though a mighty warrior, suffered from leprosy. Now the Arameans on one of their raids had taken a young girl captive from the land of Israel, and she served Naaman's wife. She said to her mistress, 'If only my lord were with the prophet who is in Samaria! He would cure him of his leprosy.' So Naaman came with his horses and chariots, and halted at the entrance of Elisha's house. Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying, 'Go, wash in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh shall be restored and you shall be clean.' But Naaman became angry and went away, saying, 'I thought that for me he would surely come out, and stand and call on the name of the LORD his God, and would wave his hand over the spot, and cure the leprosy! Are not Abana and Pharpar, the rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? Could I not wash in them, and be clean?' He turned and went away in a rage. But his servants approached and said to him, 'Father, if the prophet had commanded you to do something difficult, would you not have done it? How much more, when all he said to you was, "Wash, and be clean"?' So he went down and immersed himself seven times in the Jordan, according to the word of the man of God; his flesh was restored like the flesh of a young boy, and he was clean.

Letter to the Romans 6:12-23

Therefore, do not let sin exercise dominion in your mortal bodies, to make you obey their passions. No longer present your members to sin as instruments of wickedness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and present your members to God as instruments of righteousness. For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace. What then? Should we sin because we are not under law but under grace? By no means! Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness? But thanks be to God that you, having once been slaves of sin, have become obedient from the heart to the form of teaching to which you were entrusted, and that you, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness. I am speaking in human terms because of your natural limitations. For just as you once presented your members as slaves to impurity and to greater and greater iniquity, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness for sanctification. When you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. So what advantage did you then get from the things of which you now are ashamed? The end of those things is death. But now that you have been freed from sin and enslaved to God, the advantage you get is sanctification. The end is eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint Mark 1:35-45

In the morning, while it was still very dark, Jesus got up and went out to a deserted place, and there he prayed. And Simon and his companions hunted for him. When they found him, they said to him, 'Everyone is searching for you.' He answered, 'Let us go on to the neighboring towns, so that I may proclaim the message there also; for that is what I came out to do.' And he went throughout Galilee, proclaiming the message in their synagogues and casting out demons. A leper came to him begging him, and kneeling he said to him, 'If you choose, you can make me clean.' Moved with pity, Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, and said to him, 'I do choose. Be made clean!' Immediately the leprosy left him, and he was made clean. After sternly warning him he sent him away at once, saying to him, 'See that you say nothing to anyone; but go, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.' But he went out and began to proclaim it freely, and to spread the word, so that Jesus could no longer go into a town openly, but stayed out in the country; and people came to him from every quarter.
