Ascension Thursday

Dear Parishioners,

On Thursday, forty days after Easter and 9 days before Pentecost, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. After His resurrection, Jesus remained with His disciples, teaching them and preparing them for their mission. What does this mystery mean to us today?

Theologically, the Ascension is not simply about Jesus going up into the sky. It is a profound mystery of hope and glory. As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches: "Jesus Christ, the head of the Church, precedes us into the Father's glorious kingdom so that we, the members of His Body, may live in the hope of one day being with Him forever." (CCC 666)

In ascending to heaven, Jesus did not abandon us. Rather, He elevated our human nature to the Father, opening for us the way to eternal life. The Ascension is a declaration that heaven is our true homeland as Saint Leo the Great affirms:

"Where the head has gone, the body is called to follow."

Historically, from the early centuries, Christians have celebrated the Ascension as one of the major feasts of the liturgical year. By the fourth century, it had a fixed date — forty days after Easter — following the biblical chronology (cf. Acts 1:3). In our Maronite tradition, the liturgy is rich in hymns and prayers that reflect the joy and spiritual elevation of this mystery.

Practically, the angels said to the apostles: "Why do you stand looking up to heaven?" (Acts 1:11). This is not a call to stop looking to heaven, but rather to live with our eyes fixed on Christ, while serving His mission on earth. The Ascension teaches us today that:

- The promise of the Holy Spirit: Jesus tells the disciples to wait for the coming of the Holy Spirit Pentecost. The Ascension prepares the way for the Spirit's descent (cf. Acts 1:4-5).
- We are called to live with our hearts in heaven: As Saint Paul says, "Seek the things that are above" (Colossians 3:1). Our true homeland is in heaven, not here.
- **Jesus is still present:** Though physically absent, Christ remains with us in a new way through the Holy Spirit, the sacraments, and the Church.
- **We await His return:** The Ascension points toward the Second Coming. " *This Jesus will return in the same way as you saw Him go into heaven*" (Acts 1:11).

As we approach Pentecost, let us enter the Upper Room with Mary and the Apostles, asking the Holy Spirit to renew us. Let us lift up our hearts in prayer and live as people who belong to heaven, walking on earth with joy, hope, and mission. "Christ has ascended into heaven: let our hearts ascend with Him." – Saint Augustine.







Seventh Sunday of the Resurrection: New Commendement

Book of Leviticus 19,1-2. 11-18

The LORD spoke to Moses, saying: Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel and say to them: You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy. You shall not steal; you shall not deal falsely; and you shall not lie to one another. And you shall not swear falsely by my name, profaning the name of your God: I am the LORD. You shall not defraud your neighbour; you shall not steal; and you shall not keep for yourself the wages of a labourer until morning. You shall not revile the deaf or put a stumbling-block before the blind; you shall fear your God: I am the LORD. You shall not render an unjust judgement; you shall not be partial to the poor or defer to the great: with justice you shall judge your neighbour. You shall not go around as a slanderer among your people, and you shall not profit by the blood of your neighbour: I am the LORD. You shall not hate in your heart anyone of your kin; you shall reprove your neighbour, or you will incur guilt yourself. You shall not take vengeance or bear a grudge against any of your people, but you shall love your neighbour as yourself: I am the LORD.

Letter to the Ephesians 1, 15-23

I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love towards all the saints, and for this reason I do not cease to give thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation as you come to know him, so that, with the eyes of your heart enlightened, you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance among the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power for us who believe, according to the working of his great power. God put this power to work in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places, far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the age to come. And he has put all things under his feet and has made him the head over all things for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all.

Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Saint John 13, 31-35

When he had gone out, Jesus said, 'Now the Son of Man has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself and will glorify him at once. Little children, I am with you only a little longer. You will look for me; and as I said to the Jews so now I say to you, "Where I am going, you cannot come." I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.'
